It is an original text that develops an argument about a well-defined theme. The author may defend a thesis about a theme or answer a question. Starting in the introduction, both the thesis and the question must have their relevance and originality based on a dialogue with the state of the art related to the theme. The sections comprising the essay structure are free, but they must be coherent with each other, containing the sequence of arguments that support the thesis or help answer the formulated question. The argument should preferably be supported by theoretical references and/or published empirical studies. A section of conclusion or final considerations regarding the study question must be provided.
